ORDINATION TO THE PRIESTHOOD.

REVEREND FATHER LAURENCE BRYCE.

We offer our congratulations and extend the assurance of our prayers to Fr.Laurence Bryce following his ordination to the priesthood. Archbishop Stack was Celebrant with many priests from the Archdiocese and beyond concelebrating the Mass. Laurence's family were present together with many of his friends from across the country. Many of you will know Laurence well following his many pastoral placements here at the Cathedral during the past six years of his formation. Laurence is from the south coast of England and first came to Cardiff to study engineering at the university. Following graduation from Cardiff University (B.Eng.) he approached Archbishop Stack to request acceptance as a seminarian for this Archdiocese. He was indeed accepted and was sent to Allen Hall Seminary in Chelsea for his six year course. Seminary formation involves four arenas of exploration and development - Human, Spiritual, Pastoral and Academic. Laurence has graduated with a Diploma in Philosophy (Dip.Phil.) from the University of Maynooth, a Bachelor of Divinity (B.D.) degree from the University of London and a Bachelor of Theology (S.T.B.) degree from the Pontifical University of Leuven. In the middle of his formation journey Laurence spent a pastoral year serving in the Parish of St.Philip Evans in Llanedeyrn. The entire Archdiocese rejoices to embrace our newly ordained priest. Laurence is a man of mature integrity and is possessed by a great humility and we prayerfully entrust him to the abiding grace of Almighty God. Let us also be diligent in praying for more vocations to the priesthood. Archbishop Stack has appointed Fr.Laurence as an assistant within the Parish of All Saints in Newport where he will replace Fr.Daniel Stanton who is coming to serve the Cathedral at the end of August.
