Please keep Deacon Laurence Bryce in your prayers over the coming days as he prepares for his ordination to the priesthood, which will be celebrated at the Cathedral on Saturday 22<sup>nd</sup> June at 12.00.pm. Many of you will know Laurence well following his many pastoral placements here at the Cathedral during the past six years of his formation. Laurence is from the south coast of England and first came to Cardiff to study engineering at the university. Following graduation from Cardiff University (B.Eng.) he approached Archbishop Stack to request being accepted as a seminarian for this Archdiocese. He was indeed accepted and was sent to Allen Hall Seminary in Chelsea for his six year course of formation. Seminary formation involves four arenas of exploration and development - Human, Spiritual, Pastoral and Academic. Laurence has graduated with a Diploma in Philosophy (Dip.Phil.) from the University of Maynooth, a Bachelor of Divinity (B.D.) degree from the University of London and a Bachelor of Theology (S.T.B.) degree from the Pontifical University of Leuven. In the middle of his formation journey Laurence spent a pastoral year serving in the Parish of St.Philip Evans in Llanedeyrn. The Archdiocese rejoices in the approach of another ordination to the priesthood. Laurence is a man of mature integrity and is possessed by a great humility. We prayerfully entrust him to the abiding grace of Almighty God. As we keep Laurence in our prayers may we also prayers for more vocations to the priesthood.
