**ANNUAL 'ARANDORA STAR' MEMORIAL MASS.**

The Wales National Arandora Star Memorial, which has been established here at the Cathedral, commemorates the 53 Welsh-Italian civilians who lost their lives in the sinking of the 'Arandora Star' on 2<sup>nd</sup> July 1940. Most of the Welsh-Italian contingent aboard the ship had been born in Italy and had migrated to the U.K. following the First World War, some were born here in Wales to Italian parents. Despite the support of local townsfolk in their adopted country, these men had been interned and were bound for prison camps in Canada. The Arandora Star was torpedoed by a German U-Boat off the coast of Northern Ireland. 805 men lost their lives that night, 470 being Italians with 53 of these from Wales. During the Choral Mass today the names of the victims will be read out as we pray for their eternal repose and for the sustenance of peace and reconciliation across our world.
