### **ARCHBISHOP GEORGE STACK.**

#### **APOSTOLIC ADMINISTRATOR OF THE DIOCESE OF MENEVIA.**

On Tuesday 23<sup>rd</sup> July a Mass was celebrated at St. Joseph's Cathedral in Swansea to celebrate the retirement of Bishop Thomas Burns and the appointment of Archbishop George Stack as Apostolic Administrator of the Diocese of Menevia. At the beginning of the Mass Archbishop Stack was welcomed to the Cathedral and Diocese before being enthroned. At the conclusion of the Mass, just before the final blessing, Bishop Burns handed his Crozier to the Archbishop. Archbishop Stack has provided a retirement residence for Bishop Burns within the Archdiocese. Bishop Burns will be able to enjoy his retirement at the former presbytery next to St. Anne's Church in Malpas, Newport.

#### **CHANGES AT THE PARISH OF ST. ALBAN'S-ON-THE-MOORS, SPLOTT.**

At the request of Archbishop Stack, the Provincial of the Institute of Charity (Rosminians) and his Council have agreed to transfer the pastoral care of St. Alban's Parish to the community of the Cardiff Oratory in Formation (Oratorians). This transfer will take place during August. The Oratorians are inspired by the charism of St. Philip Neri. They engage in parish work and chaplaincies. In the autumn we will celebrate the canonisation of Blessed John Henry Newman, founder of the Oratory in Birmingham which has oversight of the Oratory in Formation here in Cardiff. We give thanks for the decades of service rendered by the Rosminians at St. Alban's and pray for a blessing upon the future ministrations of the Oratorians.

#### **OTHER CHANGES.**

Following the death of Rev. Aidan Doyle O.S.B., former Parish Priest of Leominster and Bromyard, Archbishop Stack has appointed Fr. Paul Millar as successor. Fr. Paul moves from the parishes of St. John Lloyd and Blessed Sacrament here in Cardiff. Fr. Brian Gray, Parish Priest of St. Cadoc's, is appointed to succeed Fr. Paul whilst remaining at St. Cadoc's. Please pray for both priests and for the parish communities involved in the reorganisation.
