Sacrament of Reconciliation - It is one of the great privileges as a priest to extend the healing hand of a loving and compassionate Lord in the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Pope Francis encourages us not to be afraid of going to Confession, for it is "*the sacrament of the tenderness of God, his way of embracing us*". There are several opportunities to experience the loving embrace of Christ in Confession at the Cathedral throughout the week:

Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, Fridays -
From 12 noon until 12:25pm.

Saturdays - From after the morning Mass until 12 noon, and again from 4:30pm until 5:15pm.

October, Moth of the Holy Rosary - From Tuesday, 1st October, the Holy Rosary will be prayed in the Cathedral on the weekday evenings (Monday to Friday) at 6pm. During this special month, we turn to Our Lady, seeking her intercession and protection. In the next few weeks, there will a petitions box at the shrine of Our Lady of Penrhys to post your petitions, which we will remember in prayer during the month of October. Alternatively, you can email Fr. Daniel directly at the Cathedral.

The Cathedral Choir - This weekend we welcome back from the summer break the choir from St. John's College, under the leadership of Jeff Howard. As they begin a new term, we thank them for their dedicated service and their contribution in building up the musical legacy of the Cathedral.
