# **Teas and Coffees after Sunday Morning Mass**

It's been a wonderful opportunity to get to know different parishioners and visitors of the Cathedral over these last few months; and I know that it has helped me to settle in to the Cathedral parish.

As you are aware, there is currently an open invitation to meet together at the Starbucks in Next after the 11:00am Mass each Sunday for refreshments. This open invitation will continue until the end of December.

After speaking with Spiro at the Cornerstone, we have arranged to make the *Mezzanine Floor* of the Jane Hodge Hall available to the Cathedral for refreshments after the Sunday morning Mass. Post-Mass refreshments at the Cornerstone will begin on **Sunday**, **12th January 2020**.

In order to facilitate this, I am seeking a group of volunteers who would be available to open up the rear zone of the Cornerstone and to set up for the teas and coffees. This will be done by the Cathedral community, and not the staff of the Cornerstone. The Mezzanine Floor is a self-contained area, with its own small kitchen in which we can make our own refreshments. Due to the nature of the Cornerstone, there will be a small amount of Health and Safety training involved, in case the fire alarm should go off.

Advent marks the beginning of the new liturgical year. As well as marking new beginnings, Advent is a time of expectation and preparation, where we await the second coming of the Lord, as well as His immediate coming at Christmas. At the Cathedral there are a number of ways in which we are able to prepare for the solemnity of Christmas.

## Sacrament of Reconciliation

**During Advent,** there will be extra opportunities to experience the mercy of the Lord in the Sacrament of Reconciliation:

# Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays:

12:00pm - 12:25pm 4:00pm - 5:00pm

#### Saturdays:

10:30am - 12:00pm 4:30pm - 5:15pm

Saturday, 21st December: the Sacrament of Reconciliation will be available throughout the day, with visiting priests from the diocese assisting. Confessions begin at 10:30am, after Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, and will run continuous until 5;15pm.

On the **First Sunday of Advent** we begin the Year of the Word, under the theme of *The God Who Speaks*. The Year of the Word will be solemnly opened by Archbishop George during Solemn Evening Prayer and Benediction, beginning at <u>3:30pm</u> here at the Cathedral. The music will be led by the pupils of St. Alban's Catholic High School, Pontypool.

Refreshments will be available at the Cornerstone after Evening Prayer.

During the Year of the Word, Sung Evening Prayer and Benediction will be prayed at the Cathedral each Sunday evening at <u>4:30pm</u>, where we pray for the intentions of the Archdiocese.

**Solemnity of the Immaculate** Conception is the diocesan solemnity, where we seek Our Blessed Lady's intercession. This year, the solemnity falls on **Monday, 9th December.** In

honour of the solemnity, there will be Solemn Mass at <u>6:00pm</u> at the Cathedral, celebrated by the Abbot of Belmont, Abbot Paul Stonham, followed by the crowning of the statue of Our Lady and consecration of the Archdiocese to her maternal care.

The annual Service of Lessons and Carols takes place on Sunday, 15th December 2019, beginning at 3:00pm. This year, the Carol Service is being recorded for *Shalom World Television*. We have been assured that no individual in the congregation will be filmed during the production.

After the Carol Service, refreshments and the bar will be available at the Cornerstone.
